President's Report

The Annual General Meeting of IAA (Federal) Inc took place in Sydney on 23 November 2009. The governing committee is determined to promote unity and uniformity of purpose amongst all states. In general the objects of all state associations are similar in that they should promote invention and innovation and assist all Australian Inventors in accessing current and correct information pertinent to the times. Below is an outline of possible objects of purpose to be considered:

(a) To promote, encourage and assist the Inventor with Intellectual Property, Invention, Design, Copyright, Trade Mark, Confidential Information, Know-how, Manufacture, Marketing, Dissemination of Information and aid in and effect the voluntary interchange among Associated Associations, of data, information, experience, ideas and knowledge about methods, processes and techniques relating to these processes. To establish ethical and professional standards of work and conduct for its Members.

(b) To publish and distribute books, pamphlets, periodicals, papers and articles supportive of the activities of the Association and hold Exhibitions, conferences, symposia, seminars and forums, and arrange for the presentation of lectures and papers on matters and problems of interest.

(c) To foster, promote, encourage and facilitate discussion, study and research on problems and matters of Inventing and Innovating and generally to collect and disseminate, in any manner deemed appropriate, information of service or interest to its Members or the public at large.

(d) To contact organizations with similar objectives in Australia and other countries with the purpose to exchange ideas and views.

(e) To encourage the formation and operation of organizations with similar objects throughout Australia and the World.

(f) To do all such other things as are incidental or conducive to the attainment of these objects.

The content of meetings is to be improved and have consistency with all State Associations.
